Thank you for visiting sabreez.com, and your interest in using the energy information service provided by Sabreez PBC (Sabreez, We, or Us). Your privacy is important to us. As such, we provide this privacy policy (Privacy Policy) explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is collected and used by this digital service (Service). Users are persons that use the Services.

1. **Services:** Sabreez reports wind and solar power resources relative to power coming from fossil fuels using the Wind Number and Solar Boost, which together provide an easy to understand Clean Energy Factor to motivate load shifting. We offer our information services as an application programming interface (API) and a Daily Clean Energy Forecast through our Software License.
2. **Types of Information We Collect:** Sabreez collects information through our contact form page that provides Users with the ability to provide their name and email address. Our website also collects information that is passively or automatically collected about your device, type of browser, operating system, and location.
3. **Information Collected By and From Social Media Services and Other Third Party Platforms:** You also can engage with our content on or through social media services or other third party platforms, such as Facebook, or other third-party social media plug-ins, integrations and applications. When you engage with our content on or through social media services or other third party platforms, plug-ins, integrations or applications, you may allow us to have access to certain Information in your profile. This may include your name, e-mail address, photo, gender, birthday, location, an ID associated with the applicable third party platform or social media account user files, like photos and videos, your list of friends or connections, people you follow and/or who follow you, or your posts or "likes." For a description on how social media services and other third party platforms, plug-ins, integrations or applications handle your information, please refer to their respective privacy policies and terms of use, which may permit you to modify your privacy settings.
4. **How We Use the Information Collected:** Sabreez uses the information collected from you to do the following:
 - A. To communicate with you about our Services,
 - B. Fulfill your requests regarding the Services, including without limitation requests for newsletters and notifications,
 - C. Respond to your inquiries,
 - D. Notify you of our Daily Clean Energy Forecast,
 - E. Communicate with you about our business developments,
 - F. Enforce the legal terms (including without limitation our policies and terms of service) that govern your use of our license agreement and/or for the purposes for which you provided the Information,

- G. Provide technical support for the Services,
 - H. Prevent fraud or potentially illegal activities (including, without limitation, copyright infringement) on or through the Services,
 - I. Protect the safety of our Users, and
 - J. We may combine any of the Information we collect, for any of the above purposes, and may sometimes enhance the Information with other information that we obtain from third party sources.
5. Information Sharing and Disclosure: Since our information service is shared by our licensees, information about who uses our services as Users will become public knowledge. We may also share our information as follows:
- A. To service providers or Partners that we have engaged to perform business-related functions on our behalf. This may include service providers that: (a) conduct research and analytics; (b) create content; (c) provide customer, technical or operational support; (d) conduct or support marketing (such as email or advertising platforms); (e) fulfill orders and user requests; (f) handle payments; (g) host our Services, forums and online communities; (h) administer contests; (i) maintain databases; (j) send or support online or mobile advertising; and (k) otherwise support our Services.
 - B. In response to legal process, for example, in response to a court order or a subpoena, a law enforcement or government agency's request or similar request.
 - C. With third parties in order to investigate, prevent, or take action (in our sole discretion) regarding potentially illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to any person, us, or the Services, or violations of our policies, the law or our Terms of Use, to verify or enforce compliance with the policies governing our Services.
 - D. We may share the Information with unaffiliated Partners and third parties (e.g., our third party service providers, advertisers, advertising networks and platforms, agencies, other marketers, magazine publishers, retailers, participatory databases, and non-profit organizations).

 - F. We have no control over these third parties' use of this information, which is subject to their own privacy policies.,
 - G. Fulfill your requests regarding the Services, including without limitation requests for newsletters and notifications.

6. **Cookies and other Technologies:** Cookies are pieces of information stored directly on the computer that you are using. Cookies allow us to collect information such as browser type, time spent on the Services, pages visited, language preferences, and other web traffic data. Our service providers and we use the information for security purposes, to facilitate online navigation, to display information more effectively, and to personalize your experience while using the Services, as well as for online tracking purposes. We can recognize your computer to assist your use of the Services. If you do not want information collected through the use of cookies when using the Services, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows you to automatically decline cookies or gives you the choice of declining or accepting the transfer to your computer of a particular cookie (or cookies) from a particular site. We use website and application analytics services provided by third parties that use cookies and other similar technologies to collect information about website and application use and to report trends, without identifying individual visitors. The third parties that provide us with these services may also collect information about your use of third-party websites.
